

Your rent from April 2025

From April 2025, your rent will increase by 2.7%.

This will be from 1st April 2025 if your rent is charged monthly, or 7th April 2025 if your rent is charged weekly.

We understand that any increase in rent can affect your household budgets, which is why we're committed to being open and honest with you about why we're increasing your rent. Please contact us if you are struggling or worried about how to pay your rent.

Why has your rent gone up?

As a not-for-profit organisation with rising costs impacting how we work, the rent you pay us helps ensure we deliver the essential services you rely on.

From repairs to investing in your communities, we're continually working on improving your services so you can live happily in your home.



You will not lose your home if you cannot pay your rent, as long as you work with us to manage any arrears you have.

We intend to use the rent we receive next year to help us provide your services, including the following:



Carrying out up to **36,000** repairs



Installing more than **100** solar panels to boost sustainability



Carrying out more than **10,000** gas inspections and replacing almost **500** gas boilers



Building **320** new homes for those who need them
